The orienteering club "Arboro" together with the Lithuanian Orienteering Federation invites all orienteering enthusiasts to the orienteering competition "Lithuanian Cup 2023" in Grazute, Zarasai district.

# Organizers

The competition is organized by the Lithuanian Orienteering Sports Federation. The competition is run by Orienteering Sports Club "Arboro".

# Competition map and location

The competition area is the western part of the Grazute forest between the villages of Liminiskiai and Murmuliskes. Relief forms - medium and small, the largest slopes up to 20 m high. Pits, hills, valleys, swamps of various sizes and shapes. Pine forests and spruces with good and moderate mobility are dominating. There are cuttings and young trees of various brightness and runnability. The network of roads and clearings is of medium density.

Maps updated in 2023. using the latest LIDAR data. Scale 1:10,000, for M/V14 and M/V55+ groups - 1:7500, horizontal every 2.5 m. Bmap scale 1:15,000, H 2.5 m.



# Additional information

Day 1

### Run:

From the competition center to the start (S1) - 300 m. Finish both days at the same place (F1, F2).

## OSKD:

Start (S1) same as run, finish separate from runners (F1 OSKD). After the finish, the card must be scanned in the competition center as soon as possible. The distance from the finish line to the competition center is 1.1 km.

### Day 2

### Run:

From the competition center to the start (S2) - 800 m.

### OSKD:

From the competition center to the start (S2 OSKD) - 300 m. From the start to the start of orientation, 300 m. Finish on the second day at the competition center (F1, F2)

Map change for groups: DM, DM20, DM23, DV, DV17, DV20, DV23, DV35, DV45, DV55. On the second map, the start of orientation is marked with a triangle, the numbering is continuous.

### Both days notes run:

Fresh felling is currently being done in the forest. The crossings of 10/14/2023 are marked, but it is possible that new small areas have appeared.

### OSKD notes on both days:

Unclear roads and intersections in the area will be marked. Be careful when crossing the Zarasai-Biržunai gravel road in the southeastern part of the map. Check the KP numbers and see the sequence.



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# **Competition type**

Individual two-day competitions on medium and extended medium tracks are conducted according to the rules approved by the Lithuanian orienteering federation. Competitions are held for the following orientation sports: running and mountain biking.

Please pay attention, that in registration system groups stands for V stands for Men, M stands for Women and D stands for bike.

### Starting order

In individual competitions, the participant of each group starts according to his assigned position time. In the second day's competition, the participants of the Bgroup start with a mass start. The participant is admitted to the starting area 3 minutes before the start. Group start interval - 2 min.

### Punching system

Marking is carried out by the electronic SPORTident AIR+ system. Participants will also be able to participate with regular SPORTident cards. Participants who do not have SIAC cards will be able to rent them at the competition secretariat. Rental fee - 2 €/day. For a lost SIAC card, participants pay its price according to valid rates.

### Registration

Applications are submitted in the DB Topas system <u>https://dbsportas.lt/lt/varz</u> Registration is carried out until 2023. October 16 23:59 **After this date, registration is only possible if possible, i.e. i.e. free start minutes at the front of the protocol, prepared maps, numbers, etc.** 

### Fees

For athletes who have submitted registered applications, the participation fee specified by the competition organizers shall be paid by bank transfer or at the place of the competition. To partially cover the costs of organizing the competition, the participants pay the fee set by the Lithuanian orienteering federation age group for each person:

Registration after 10/17/2023 only if places are available. After registering, but not starting, the start fee is not refunded.

# Determination of results

In the Lithuanian Cup competitions, the winners are determined based on the total sum of the results of the two days. The participants of groups M/V 20, M/V 23, M/V bei DM/DV20, DM/DV 23 and DM/DV compete on the same track, but the results of these groups are presented in a common list, indicating next to each M/V 20, M/V 23, DV20/DM20 and DV23/DM23 participant, which place he occupied in his group. Athletes from these groups claim awards in the elite group as well.

## GPS

Top list of V/M 20, V/M 23, V/M and DM/DV20, DM/DV 23, DM/DV competitors will have GPS assigned that have to weared on track.

### Awards

## Other information

• Participants are responsible for their own health and safety during the competition, their coaches or accompanying persons are also responsible for children. All participants of the competition must have a medical permission to participate in the competition.





- Meals, accommodation and travel expenses of athletes and coaches are paid by the sending organization or the athletes themselves.
- Claims must be submitted to the competition jury or competition organizers within 1 hour of the participant's finish time, but in any case as early as possible.
- All participants must start with the participant number issued by the organizers. Athletes starting without a participant number will be disqualified.
- By registering, the participants of the competition agree that their name, surname, year of birth, team and results will be published on the competition registration page <u>http://www.dbsportas.lt</u> and during the competition they may be photographed, videotaped, their location determined in real time, and the material can be used to publicize competitions and popularize sports. Participants can contact the LOSF (Lithuanian orienteering sports federation) administration regarding the use of personal data in accordance with the valid LOSF privacy policy.


