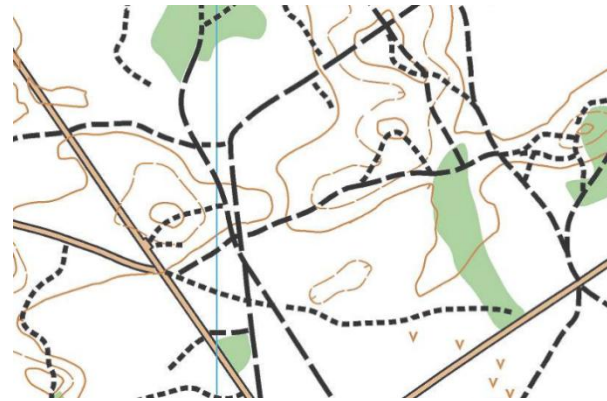

Age groups and participation restrictions

The competition is held in the following age groups:

DM/DV, DM/DV 12, 14, 17, 20, 23, 35, 45, 55, 65, 75.

OPEN 1, OPEN2

Attention! DM groups are for women and DV groups are for men.

Only Lithuanian citizens and official residents can compete for Lithuanian Championship awards.

Only Lithuanian, Latvian, Estonian citizens and official residents can compete for Baltic Championship awards.

Athletes from Russia and Belarus are not allowed to participate in the competition.

90 min. (sprint), 120 min. (middle), 150 min. (mass start).

Start procedure

All participants start according to the time assigned to him. The participant is allowed into the starting corridor 3 minutes before the start. The group start interval is 2 minutes.

Punching and time-keeping

SPORTident Air+ a system for contactless punching with SI Active Cards (SIAC) with a working range of 150 – 180 cm will be used. Competitors may use their own SIAC. Rental SIACs will be available from the organizers for 2 € per 1 competition day.

Registration is open until June 22, 2026. After this date, registration is possible only with a 1.5 times higher fee. Registration for OPEN groups is also possible on the competition day at event center.

The winners of the Baltic Championship (1-3 places) in each age group are awarded medals.

Awards are presented only to athletes who participate in the awards ceremony in person.

Other information

Participants are responsible for their own health and safety during the competition, as are their coaches or accompanying persons. All participants must have a valid medical certificate allowing them to participate in the competition.

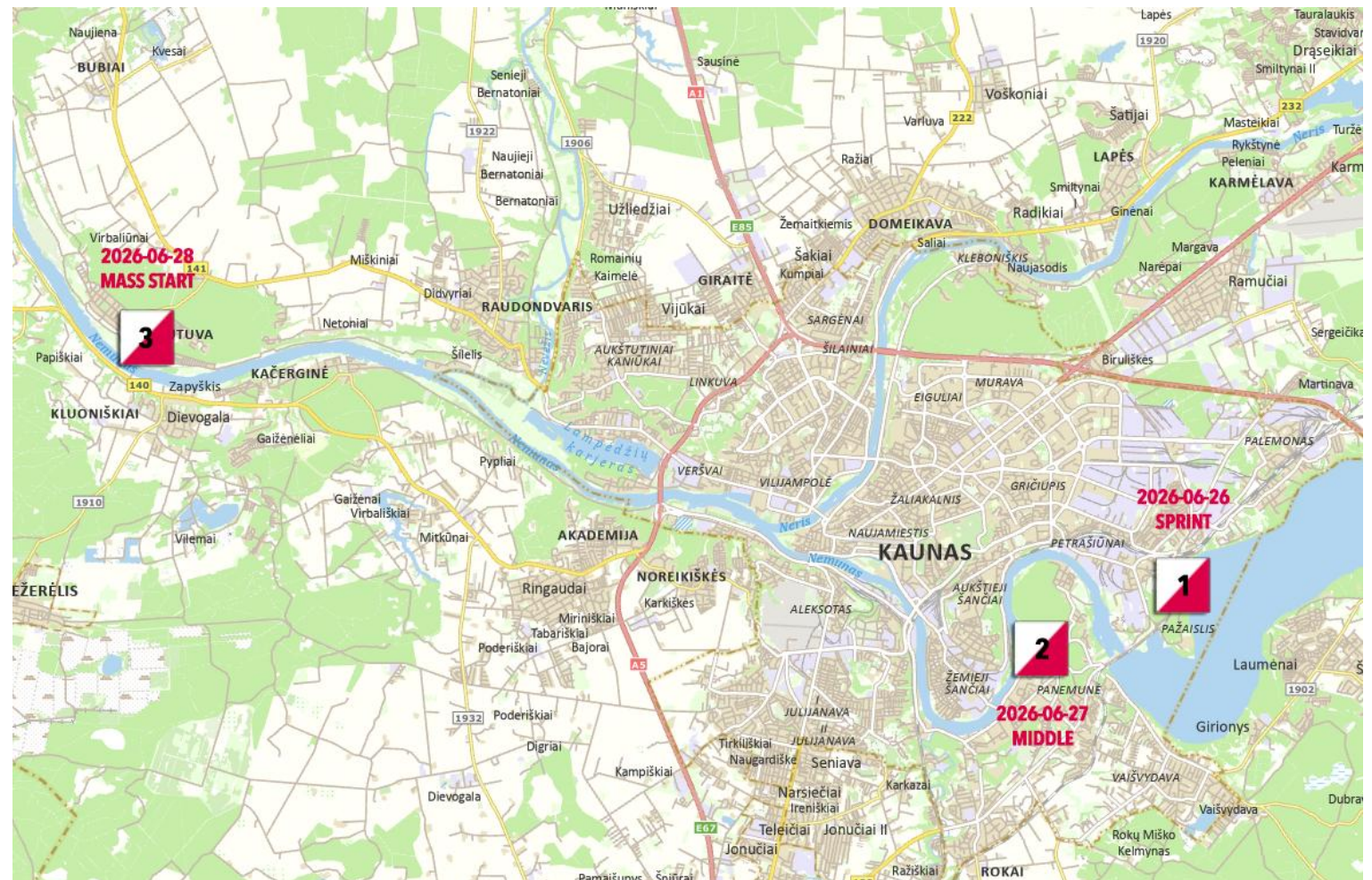
The sending organization or the athletes themselves pay for the meals, accommodation and travel expenses of the athletes and coaches.

Complaints must be submitted to the competition jury or the competition organizers within 1 hour of the participant's finish time, but in any case as early as possible.

All participants must start with the participant number issued by the organizers. Athletes starting without a participant number will be disqualified.

By registering, participants agree that their name, surname, year of birth, team and results will be

published on the competition registration page <http://www.dbsportas.lt> and that during the competition they may be photographed, filmed, their location determined in real time, and the material may be used to publicize the competition and promote sports.
