Competition Type

Individual orienteering competition with two-day overall results in prolonged middle and middle courses (available in Foot-O and MTB-O).

Competition Map and Terrain

Noškūnai Forest, map prepared in 2026. Map author – S. Kireilis.

Scale 1: 7 500 and 1: 10 000, contour interval 2,5 m.

In September 2026, the qualification races for the European Orienteering Championships will take place in this area. A coniferous forest, with good and medium runnability. Terrain: the Nemunas River slope features fairly large landforms of up to 40 m, gradually transitioning into a gently rising surface dissected by various medium-sized and small features. The elevation difference from the Nemunas River up to the highest hilltops exceeds 100 meters. The network of roads, clearings and paths is medium dense.

Age Groups and Participants

Foot-O: M/V, MS/VS*, M/V 8*, 10*, 10-14N*, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, OpenS*, OpenL*.

MTB-O: DM/DV, DM/DV 12, 14, 17, 20, 35, 45, 55, 65, 75.

*MV 8, 10 groups – marked course (~2-2,5 km).

*MV 8, MV 10-14N groups participants can complete the course together with an accompanying person (start at a freely chosen time while the start window is open).

*MS/VS – shorter course.

*OpenL – longer course, OpenS – shorter course.

Punching System

Punching will be carried out using the electronic SPORTident AIR+ system. In the foot orienteering competition only, competitors may also use standard SPORTident cards. Competitors who do not have a SPORTident card, may rent one at the event secretariat. The rental fee is 2 EUR. Competitors who lose a rented SPORTident card must pay its replacement cost according to the current price list.

Registration

Applications are submitted via system <https://dbsportas.lt/lt/varz>. Registration open until 23:59 on 12 October, 2026. After this date, registration will be accepted if places are available, with a 1,5 times higher fee. On the event day registration only possible for OPEN groups (the entry fee remains unchanged). Competitors who enter for one day pay half of the listed entry fee.

Open groups entry fee: OpenL – 15 Eur/ day, OpenS – 11 Eur/ day.

Entry fees are non-refundable for competitors who register but do not start.

Competitor without a LOSF license must pay an additional fee on top of the entry fee: adult 2 Eur/ day, school student – 0,5 Eur/ day. During registration, increased entry fee will be applied automatically.

Payment

Entry fee is paid on-site in cash or via bank transfer. Clubs can pay entry fees via bank transfer based on the invoice issued after the event.

Awards

The Lithuanian Cup winners are determined by the two-day overall results and are awarded with special prism-shaped commemorative trophies. The top three competitors in each class (1–3 places) receive sponsors' prizes, which are presented in person to athletes attending the prize-giving ceremony.

Other information

- Participants are responsible for their own health and safety during the competition; for school students, responsibility lies with their coaches or accompanying persons. All participants must have a valid medical certificate permitting them to participate in the competition.
- The costs of meals, accommodation, and travel for athletes and coaches are covered by the sending organization or by the athletes themselves.
- Any claims or appeals to the competition jury or organizers must be submitted within 1 hour after the participant finishes, but in any case, as soon as possible.
- All participants must start with the race number provided by the organizers. Athletes who start without a race number will be disqualified.

- By registering, competition participants agree that their name, surname, year of birth, team, and results will be published on the competition registration website <http://www.dbsportas.lt>, and that they may be photographed, filmed, and their location tracked during competition. This material may be used for event promotion and for the promotion of orienteering. Participants may contact the LOSF administration regarding the use of personal data in accordance with the current LOSF privacy policy.
